We also promote the importance of greenhouse gas emissions management for the economic, social and environmental well-being of its employees, customers and businesses.

- a) Reducing our process emissions of greenhouse gases.
- b) Reducing our dependency high carbon footprint power sources.
- c) Reducing dependency on GHG emitting transport and commuting methods.

1. Setting objectives and targets and developing GHG action plans.
2. Measuring the GHG carbon footprint of energy sources and transportation on an ongoing basis and using this information to regularly review policy, objectives, targets and the allocation of resources.
3. Raising awareness amongst employees on GHG emissions; encouraging, guiding and supporting staff to act in accordance with this GHG policy.
4. Inform stakeholders of overarching GHG goals.
5. Annually Publish our Co2 Emissions Report.

We are making available all the necessary information and appropriate resources to achieve any objective and target in this regard.
